

<p>RICMS (Reentry Intensive Case Management Services)</p> <p>Providing case management and service navigation via Community Health Workers with lived experience</p>	<p>Breaking Barriers</p> <p>Providing housing, tenancy support, case management and employment services to justice impacted individuals experiencing homelessness</p>	<p>SECTOR (Skills and Experience for the Careers of Tomorrow)</p> <p>Training and paid work experience in high growth sectors that offer pathways and family-sustaining wages to justice impacted individuals</p>
<p>DOORS (Developing Opportunities & Offering Reentry Solutions)</p> <p>Housing, employment, legal aid, and more for justice impacted individuals, particularly those on adult felony supervision</p>		<p>POWR (Providing Opportunities for Women in Reentry)</p> <p>Serving system involved women who are 18 + with peer-led mentorship, interim housing, care coordination and more</p>
<p>YO! (Youth Overcoming)</p> <p>Transformative mentorship curriculum for transitional age youth age 18-26 incl. group support sessions, transportation to and from court appointments, case management and more</p>	<p>Reentry Interim Housing</p> <p>Providing interim housing to prevent and reduce homelessness and reduce recidivism</p>	<p>College and Careers</p> <p>Providing voluntary supportive services for individuals on adult felony probation</p>
